



INSTRUCTIONS BFC1345 SPARKLING FLOWERS

These designs were created to use with Angelina Film or Fibers. They will probably also work with Mylar, but I haven't tested them for Mylar.

Designs in set:	MEDIUM	LARGE	JUMBO

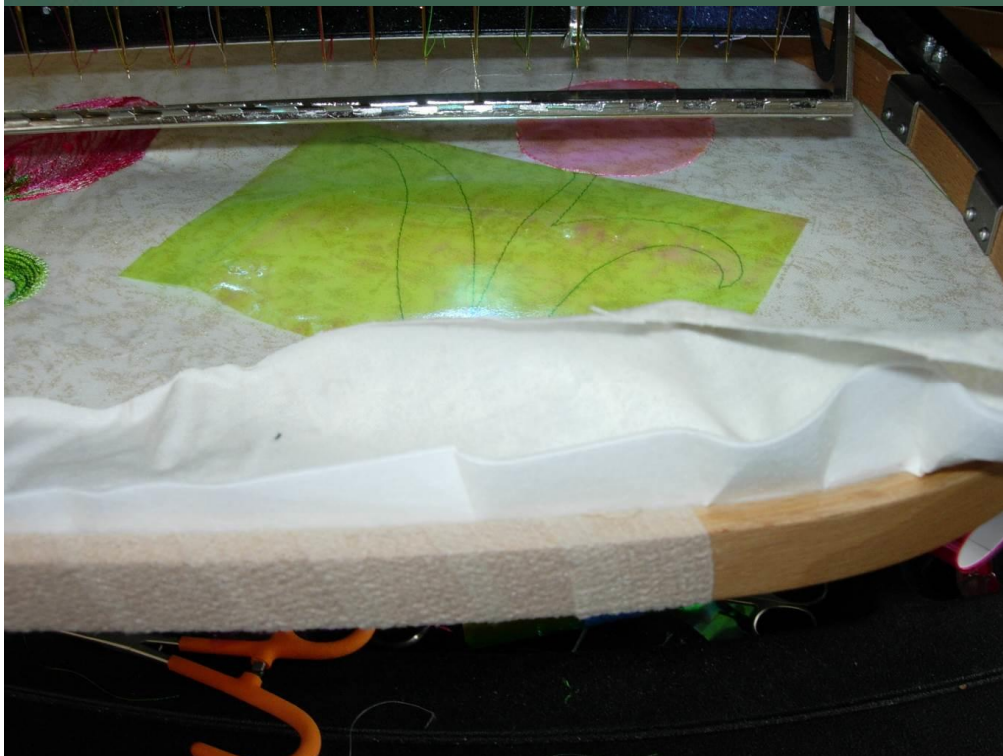
STITCHING THE DESIGNS

1. Stitch basting 1, remove hoop from machine
2. Place a piece of Angelina film or Fibers large enough to cover the stitching and secure. I like to use Scotch Magic Tape – it doesn't damage fabric. Return hoop to machine
3. Stitch Basting 2. Remove hoop and trim film or fibers close to the stitching. Return hoop to machine
4. Stitch remainder of the design.

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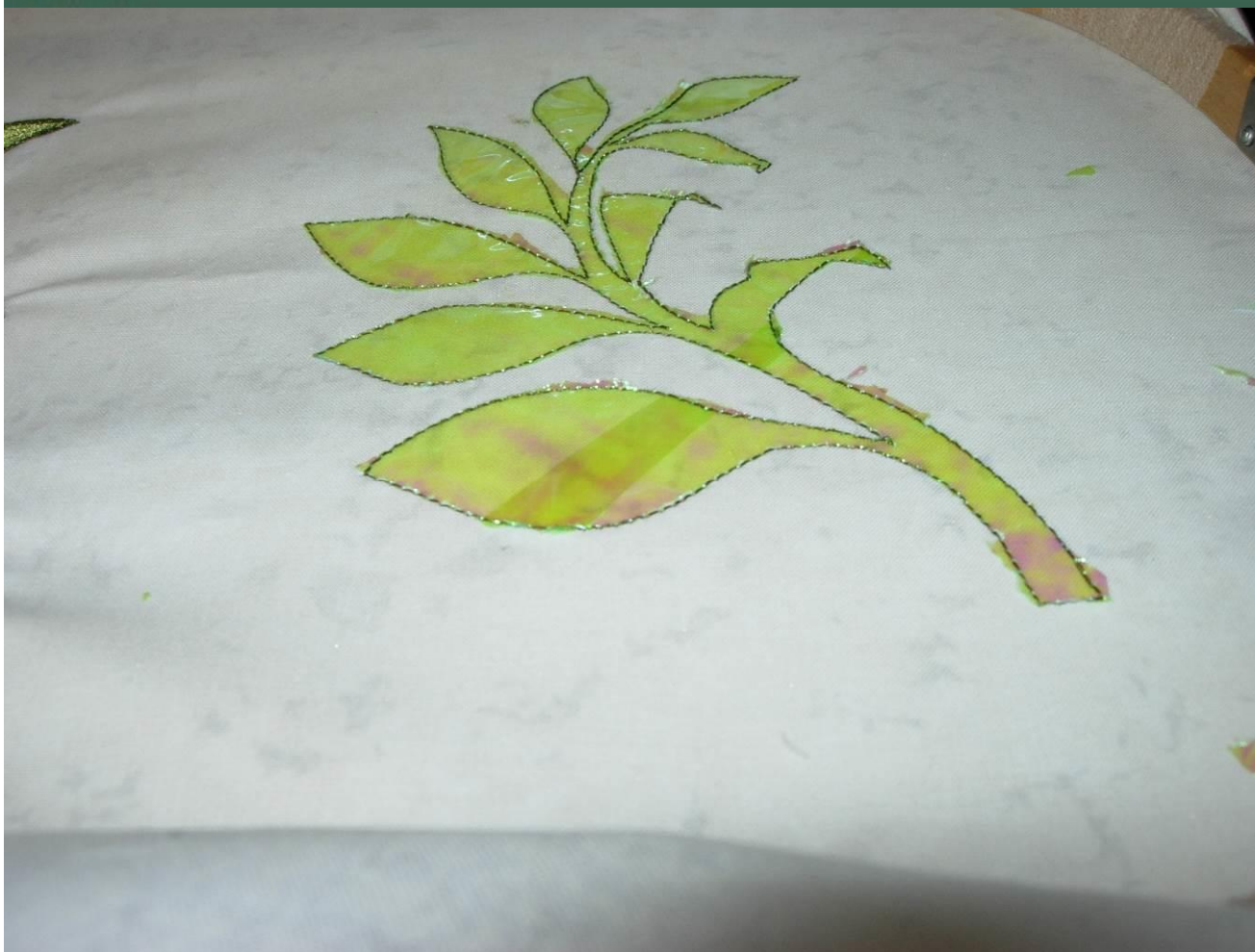


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You can piece Angelina film if you need to. Just slide another piece under the first one and tape in place.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR TOTE BAG

You will need two pieces of fabric for the outer bag and a different one for the lining if desired. (Or you can use one of the main fabrics)

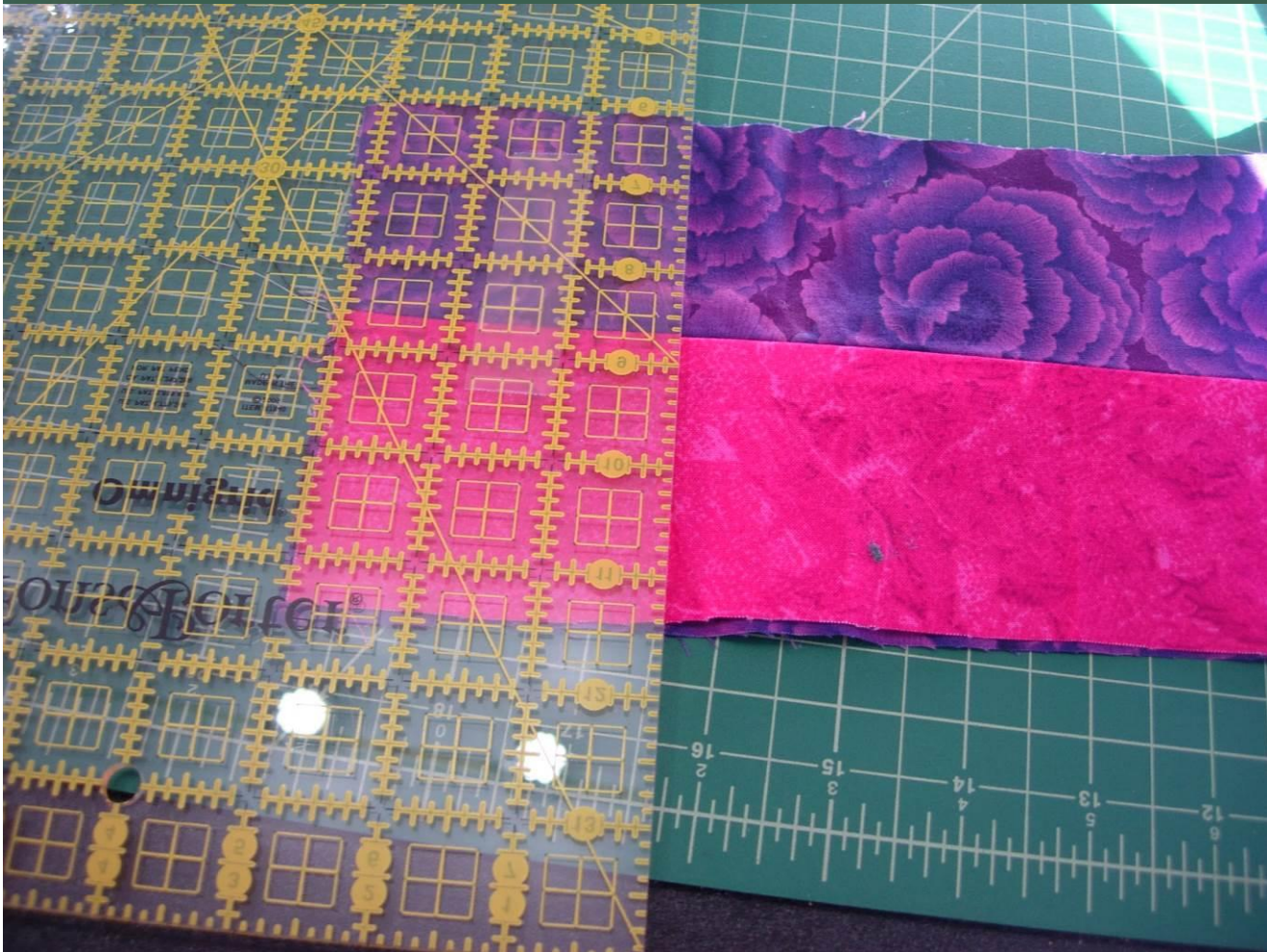
Cut two pieces each of the two main fabrics, 12" x 3". Stitch one of each color together lengthwise.

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Place one on top of the other and cut 3" pieces across.

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Now take two of the pieces, and making sure the colors alternate, stitch them together.

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Stitch 2 sets of 4 pieces each in this manner.

DESIGN

Stitch your design on a piece of fabric that will be large enough to cut it 12” high. I cut my design section 6.5” wide. Stitch one of your strips on either side of your design.

Cut a 4 inch strip the width of your assembly for the bottom and one 3.5” by the width of your assembly for the top. Stitch to assembly.

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Cut a piece for the back 11" wide by the height of your assembly. Matching right sides of back and front, stitch seams. Your back will be smaller so some of the squares will show.

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Stitch across the bottom and press.

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Add buttonholes or eyelets to your bag. Place these 1.5" from the top of the bag and centered on each side.

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Cut a piece of fabric for the lining twice the width of your bag plus 1" x the height of your bag. Fold in half and stitch side seam and bottom, leaving an opening in the bottom to turn. Slide your lining, right side in over your bag and match tops. Stitch around the top.

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Run cord through your eyelets or buttonholes. To make a drawstring, you need two pieces of cord. I cut each of mine about 46". Starting from eyelet, insert the end of the cord (I added a small safety pin to the end of mine) through the eyelet and all the way around the bag, coming out in the same eyelet you started with. Now repeat with another piece of cord with the other eyelet. Knot ends of the cords together on each. You can add one or two large beads before tying the knot if you wish.
